Is it possible (and supported) to run individual Macintosh Toolbox offthe-shelf applications under A/UX 3.0 WITHOUT launching 7.0 MultiFinder? In other words, will A/UX 3.0 support A/UX 1.1 functionality, allowing me to launch individual applications from the command line, and return to the command line after I quit each application?

DISCUSSION -----
