TOPIC
Has anything changed between A/UX $2.0.1$ and A/UX 3.0 that would require users or developers to recompile their UNIX applications to get them to run?
DISCUSSION
You don't need to recompile Macintosh applications.
You do need to recompile A/UX Hybrids.
Straight UNIX applications SHOULDN'T need recompiling if they're using shared libraries. The only changes to the kernel are for NFS.
