I need to know what kind of compatibility to expect for A/UX 3.0 with the following software:

- Databases: Oracle, Informix, Sybase, Ingres (Which versions?)
- Motif from ICS (Does the version for A/UX 2.0.1 work under 3.0?)
- DAL (which version and which databases?)
- SoftPC

DISCUSSION -----

Oracle

The current version of Oracle for A/UX is version 6.0.

Informix

According to Informix, the Informix 4.0 DBMS products for A/UX that include the tools, Informix-SQL and Informix-4GL, and the engines Informix-Online and Informix-SE, are the current released products.

Sybase

According to Sybase, four SQL tool sets currently support A/UX. These are:

- APT (Application Productivity Tools) Workbench, version 4.0.2
- Open Client C (DB Library), version 4.0.2
- Data Workbench, version 4.1
- Report Execution, version 4.1

The Ask Group, Inc./Ingres Products (formerly Ingres)

According to Ask/Ingres Sales, the Ingres for A/UX 2.0 stopped shipping September '91. We don't know why.

Motif

Motif from ICS for A/UX works on both A/UX 2.0.1 and 3.0.

DAL

The DAL server for A/UX, version 1.3 is the current released version that supports Informix 4.0 and 2.1, and Oracle DBMS.

SoftPC and Compilers

According to tests, SoftPC by Insignia was found to be compatible but may have cosmetic bugs.

To locate a vendor's address and phone number, use the vendor name as a search string.
