TOPIC
A user gets the message
"loop:bad value"
before the Ethernet messages on A/UX startup. All Ethernet communications work well. Is this message related to Ethernet, or something else?
DISCUSSION
This error message comes from the startup script BNET in /etc/startup.d. It can be caused by an incorrect entry in the /etc/hosts file for the loop address. The line for the loop address should look like this:
127.0.0.1 loop loo lo localhost Software_Loopback Copyright 1989 Apple Computer, Inc.
