| The version of 'awk' that comes with A/UX 3.0 was based on the new version of awk (nawk) from AT&T ToolChest $1988-1989$. |
| Actually the 'nawk' has been in A/UX since A/UX 2.0.1 release. A/UX, however, still uses the name of 'awk' instead of 'nawk'. |
| To verify that we are using the new version of 'awk', search for the built-in gsub from 'man awk' or 'strings /bin/awk', if it exists, it is nawk. The old awk does not support the gsub function. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc. |
