A/UX: Visual Editor Set To TextEditor (8/93)

TOPIC -----

I'm using A/UX 3.0 and I'm having problems using the visual editor feature of mailx. In my .mailrc file, I have:

```
set VISUAL=/mac/bin/TextEditor
```

When creating a mail message, using mailx, I issue the "~v" command, and TextEditor comes up, showing a filename of /tmp/Re####, where #### is some random number. After typing some text, I save it, and then get the following error message: "Can't write onto file 'Re####' with an okay button." When I quit, I get a "save changes?" dialog, but I still get the same error. I have plenty of free disk space on "/" when this is occurring. Any suggestions as to what is going wrong?

DISCUSSION -----

We are able to reproduce this problem in A/UX 3.0, it's a TextEditor bug in A/UX 3.0. However, it worked under A/UX 3.0.1 and an Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95.

We suggest you upgrade to A/UX 3.0.1.
