

Retrospect A/UX: Multiple Hard Disks & NFS Volumes (8/93)

TOPIC -----

This article provides technical information on backing up multiple hard disks and NFS volumes under A/UX 3.0.1 with Retrospect A/UX.

DISCUSSION -----

Retrospect treats each A/UX file system separately, whether it is another hard disk or an NFS volume. As it scans files within the hierarchy, Retrospect will not descend within a mount point to cross a device boundary. This is also true for backing up or erasing files.

To back up or erase a mounted device or mounted NFS volume, you must define that device's mount point as a Retrospect subvolume, then back it up or erase it separately.
