## ABS Tech Note: DAL13 DB2 and SQL/DS Views (9/92)

TOPIC
This article describes the creation of a view within DB2 or $SQL/DS$ that will return different table listings.
DISCUSSION
It is possible to create a view within DB2 or SQL/DS that will return different table listings (for example, when using the 'Describe Tables' command within DAL) based upon authority GRANTed to a particular user ID
To implement this, change the value of 'DESTAB=' in the DAL Environment file to equal 'CREATOR.VIEWNAME'. Then, have the database adminstrator create the following view using the standard SQL utilities (for example, SPUFI).
The following is an example for DB2:
<pre>create view CREATOR.VIEWNAME (tcreator, ttname) as select distinct creator, name     from sysibm.systabauth a, sysibm.systables b     where a.tcreator = b.creator         and a.ttname = b.name         and a.granteetype = ' '         and a.grantee = user</pre>
For SQL/DS, replace 'sysibm' with 'system' in the above example. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
