TOPIC
Is there a need to run PC/NFS, BWNFSD and/or another authentication daemons on the Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95?
DISCUSSION
To run AppleShare Pro and have Macintosh Clients you do not need to run either PC/NFSD or BWNFSD. For the AWS 95 to become an NFS server, you have to configure the kernel to have NFS support via a simple newconfig command (newconfig nfs). This will start /etc/nfsd. If the system will also be used as an NFS client, the /etc/biod can also be started. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
