Workgroup Server 9150: Video Support (4/94)

TOPIC -----

This article describes the video capability of the Workgroup Server 9150 (WS 9150).

DISCUSSION -----

The WS 9150 uses DRAM for video buffering when connecting to the built-in DB-15 socket on the back of the computer. This DB-15 socket supports these monitors:

Monitor	Size (pixels)	Color depth (bits)
-----	-----	-----
12-inch RGB	512 by 384	16
14-inch RGB	640 by 480	16
15-inch portrait	640 by 870	8
16-inch RGB	832 by 624	8
VGA	640 by 480	8

Bandwidth limitations prevent the WS 9150 from supporting 16 bit pixel depths on the larger monitors.

For larger monitors on the WS 9150 use either a NuBus, or PDS video card. The amounts of VRAM on the card will support larger monitors at greater color depth.
