Printing Grayscale: Requires at Least a 68020 Processor (7/93)

TOPIC -----

Can I print grays from a PowerBook 100 to a StyleWriter II? In the Print window, the Print Grays option is grayed out. That option is available on my Classic II, so why won't my PowerBook offer it?

DISCUSSION -----

The StyleWriter II requires Color QuickDraw, which needs at least a 68020 processor to run. Therefore, it is unavailable to the Macintosh Classic, Plus, SE and PowerBook 100s. On these systems, only black and white printing is possible. The Classic II, as you discovered, has a 68030 processor, so it can handle Color QuickDraw and grayscale printing.
