## PowerBook: SCSI Termination Differs from Other Macintosh Models

### TOPIC -----

The Macintosh User's Guide for PowerBooks says that you need two terminators when connecting to one SCSI peripheral.

Is this correct? This is not true for any other Macintosh.

### DISCUSSION -----

The manual is correct. Due to differences in the internal termination scheme, the PowerBooks require two terminators for one to six external SCSI devices. Other Macintosh computers require one terminator for one device, and two terminators for more devices.
