What are the differences between the Performa 405 and 430, and between the Performa 430 and 450? And how do they compare with the Performa 600 and 600CD?

DISCUSSION -----

What the Performa 405, 430, and 450 Have in Common

- Complete system. The computer (the main unit), color display (monitor), keyboard, mouse, fax/data modem, microphone, and software are all included. You need no additional software or cables to begin using a Performa 405, 430, or 450. In addition, these models are packed in a single box: computer, display, and accessories all in one carton.
- Ease of use. Like all Apple Macintosh computers, these Performa models are easy to set up, learn, and use.
- Software already installed. All three models feature System 7.1P, disability access features, At Ease, Macintosh PC Exchange, Launcher, and a selection of productivity and communication software.
- Compatibility. Each of these Performa models has a built-in SuperDrive, which can read disks from Macintosh, Apple II, MS-DOS, and Windows computers. AppleTalk is built in to every model.
- Service & Support. All three models feature one year limited warranty, one year free in-home service, and a toll-free help line.

How They Differ -----The following table summarizes the differences among the three models, as well as the Performa 400, 600, and 600CD.
