

Power Macintosh: NEC Multisync Requires Adapter (6/94)

TOPIC -----

I have a NEC MultiSync 4FG monitor and the monitors control panel, on my Power Macintosh, only gives me a resolution of 640x480. Is there a way to get a higher resolution?

DISCUSSION -----

NEC has a special adapter for the Power Macintosh computer called the "Power Macintosh Adapter". This allows Power Macintosh owners to change resolutions using the monitors control panel. These adapters are available directly from NEC.

You don't need adapters to use NEC's "dpi on the fly" software with the Macintosh Centris, Quadra, or LC computers. The "dpi on the fly" software is not comptatible with the Power Macintosh.

To locate a vendor's address and phone numbers, use the vendor name as the search string.
