Power Macintosh: Sampled Sound Playback Issue (3/94)

TOPIC -----

This article describes sampling rate playback change.

DISCUSSION -----

The sampling rate of 22.05 kHz replaced the sampling rate of 22.254 kHz in older Macintosh models. This new rate was changed for compatibility with the 44.1 kHz audio CD sampling rate.

For sound samples made at the 22.254 kHz rate, playback at the 22.05 kHz results in a 1% change in pitch (lower).
