

System 7 Finder: Repairing Preferences File that Loses Settings

TOPIC
We have Macintosh computers (PowerBook 170 and IIcx) running System 7. They won't retain default settings, such as changes to Views (like font size) or the Trash warning. After a restart or shut down, the settings return to default. Zapping the PRAM doesn't help.
DISCUSSION
It sounds like you might have a corrupted Finder Preferences file, found by following this path:
System Folder Preferences Finder Preferences
Try the following procedure:
- Throw the Finder Preferences file away.
- Restart your computer. (This will automatically create a new Finder Preferences file.) Copyright 1992, Apple Computer, Inc.
