## MacWrite II: Locks Up on Macintosh with More Than 16MB of RAM

TOPIC -----

MacWrite II 1.1v2 locks up my Quadra (20MB RAM, 32-bit addressing, cache on or off) every time I try to run the spell checker. Is this a known bug, and is there a fix?

DISCUSSION -----

Claris Tech Support says this is a recognized problem with all versions of MacWrite II and any CPU with over 16MB of RAM. MacWrite II must load into low memory to get around this problem. One way to do this is to make the system heap 4MB or larger. This will leave 16MB of memory available, allowing MacWrite II to run properly. You can do this by increasing the RAM cache to 4MB. Another way is by loading 4MB of applications into memory before running MacWrite II.
