What is the "Content Damaged" error in Retrospect?

DISCUSSION -----

The "Content Damaged" error message appears if you change the name of a disk or cartridge that is part of a Disk StorageSet.

What to do: If you want to preserve this data, rename the disk to the original name it was given by Retrospect. The original disk uses the format "1-The StorageSet." If you do not want to save the data and want to use the disk for other purposes, erase the disk using the Erase Disk command from the Special menu in the Finder.
