What is an "internal consistency check error" in Retrospect?

DISCUSSION -----

An internal consistency check error occurs if Retrospect experiences a major problem during operation not due to normal errors or circumstances.

When this happens, Retrospect creates an error log, in the Retrospect preferences folder, named "Retrospect.error.log.n" where n is a long number.

What to do: If you experience one of these errors, contact Dantz Technical Support and send us the error log along with a brief description of the circumstances surrounding the failure.
