TOPIC -----

What is a Retrospect StorageSet Catalog and why do I need it?

DISCUSSION -----

A Catalog keeps track of which files are stored on the StorageSet, and where these files are located on the media. Do not delete the Catalog file. The Catalog is required to retrieve files from a StorageSet or make subsequent backups to it. If you lose a Catalog accidentally, you can rebuild it from your backup media. See "Recreating a Catalog" on page 163 for details. Rebuilding a Catalog may take several hours if you have a large amount of data.
