| After Dark 2.0x is 100% System 7.1 compatible. This new version is a maintenance upgrade and addresses some minor incompatibilities and bug fixes. After Dark 2.0x includes a new installer application, along with the option to globally mute all sounds from within the After Dark Control Panel. |
| The PowerBooks power conservation features will make After Dark's animation slow down dramatically, then disappear completely. The settings for these features are located in the PowerBook (formerly Portable) Control Panel. To turn off these PowerBook features so that After Dark's animation can continue uninterrupted, please consult your PowerBook manual. |
