When I try opening a very large document (37 MB), from my APS Technologies hard disk, I can only get about 1/4th of the way through the document before the computer freezes up. Smaller documents work without any problems, it just seems to be the large documents. Why?

DISCUSSION -----

According to APS Technologies, the problem is using blind reading and writing to the hard disk. In the APS SCSI driver software V2.8, you need to disable automatic blind reads and writes. For additional information or software upgrades, contact APS Technologies.
