Page 14 of the Macintosh PC Exchange manual states that you can create a mapping for a DOS file with "no suffix". However, if you try to do this, you get the message "To complete the assignment, the DOS suffix must be specified". Is the manual incorrect?

DISCUSSION -----

The Macintosh PC Exchange manual is incorrect: it is not possible to create a mapping for a DOS file without the three-character extension, referred to in the Macintosh PC Exchange manual as a "suffix". Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
