400MB HDA: Use in HD20 SC Cabinet Not Supported

TOPIC -----

Can I place a 400MB internal drive in an old Apple Hard Disk 20SC (and 40, 80 or 160) drive case, and have enough power for the drive to work effectively?

DISCUSSION -----

Although this will work, technically this "upgrade" isn't supported, and will void the warranty.

The power supply in the Hard Disk 20SC (and 40, 80 and 160) provides for current loads of up to 2.0 amps on the 5 volt line and 1.5 amps on the 12 volt line.

The 400MB HDA draws a maximum of 0.9 amps on the 5 volt line and 1.0 amp on the 12 volt line.
