## HyperCard 2.3.x: Bitmap Printing on Some Power Macintosh (2/96)

TOPIC -----

When I try to print from HyperCard 2.3 or HyperCard Player 2.3 from my Power Macintosh 5200/75 LC, the text from text fields prints bitmapped. HyperCard 2.2 prints stacks fine from the same computer.

DISCUSSION -----

Apple engineering has duplicated this issue with HyperCard 2.3 on Power Macintosh 7500/100, 7200/90, and 5200/75 LC computers only.

This issue is thought to be related to the HyperCard 2.3 engine, not any particular stack. HyperCard 2.2 prints fine on these computers.

This issue is being corrected in HyperCard 2.3.5.

However, a separate issue regarding buttons remains with HyperCard 2.3.5. Any card containing a button with either of these combinations always prints bitmapped.
