QuickTake 100: Copy & Pasting in MS-Windows (11/94)

TOPIC -----

I am using the QuickTake 100 software with MS-Windows 3.1, and I cannot always copy and paste images from the QuickTake software into all Window Applications. I can copy and paste into some applications like Microsoft Word, Excel, and Powerpoint, but not into Lotus Notes. Is there a way to directly paste into all applications from the QuickTake software?

DISCUSSION -----

The QuickTake application creates compressed JPEG files. Microsoft Word, Excel and Powerpoint can use the compressed JPEG files, but any application that cannot support the JPEG format, cannot use the copy and paste option.

The only workaround for your problem, is to use an application like Adobe Photoshop or Aldus PhotoStyler to export the QuickTake JPEG file as a PICT file. Once the file is in this format, you should be able to copy and paste between applications.
