

## Quadra 610: Start with Apple Restoration CD, 9/94 Disk 1 (6/95)

TOPIC -----

Our Quadra 610 has a suspected corrupted system folder on the hard disk, and we wish to do a clean install to the original System 7.1 and Update 3.0 from the 9/94 restoration CD. The Restoration CD documentation specifies Disk 1, configuration 694-0251 as the proper install package for with this computer. However, when booting from the CD, following the happy Mac window at power up, a dialog appears with the message "This startup disk won't work on this Macintosh model. Use the latest installer to update this disk for this model." What is wrong?

DISCUSSION -----

This is a known problem and Apple is working on a resolution. The workaround is to start your Macintosh with a bootable hard drive and then run the Restoration CD installer program from the Other Items window that appears in the Finder.
