Quark Express: Full Justified Text Jagged on StyleWriter (9/95)

TOPIC -----

I am using a Color StyleWriter 2400, and when I print justified or forced justified Type 1 or TrueType text in Quark XPress 3.3.1, the character spacing is incorrect in some words (either extra space or not enough resulting in overprinting) and the right margin is ragged. I am using Boton Regular (installed with ATM 3.8.1) and Bookman TrueType.

DISCUSSION -----

Apple engineering is aware of this issue and plans to resolve it in future releases of the affected printer drivers.

This problem has been reported on the Color StyleWriter 2400, and may also occur on the StyleWriter 1200, the Color StyleWriter Pro, and the Personal LaserWriter 300. Since all of these drivers are backward compatible with previous printers like StyleWriter I & II and the Personal LaserWriter LS, the problem may occur with those printers as well.

One workaround offered by Quark to resolve this issue is to rotate the affected text box by .01 degrees.
