

Macintosh Color Display: How Its Size Is Measured

How does Apple measure the Macintosh Color Display?
DISCUSSION
The Macintosh Color Display measures approximately 14 inches from corner to corner of the CRT (with the front bezel removed). This is the industry standard method of measuring displays, and all display vendors call this CRT size a 14" display.
Apple formerly measured its displays from inside corner to inside corner of the front bezel. By this measurement, the Macintosh Color Display and the previous AppleColor High-Resolution RGB Display measure approximately 13". Copyright 1992, Apple Computer, Inc.
