With what Macintosh models can I use a serial HD-20?
DISCUSSION
Support of the serial $HD-20s$ is not tied to System Software, but to the ROM in the respective systems.
The following Macintosh models have support for the serial (non-SCSI) HD-20 built into ROM: • Macintosh 512Ke • Macintosh Plus • Macintosh SE • Macintosh Classic • Macintosh IIci • Macintosh Portable
The following Macintosh models do NOT have this support built in: • Macintosh SE/30 • Macintosh II • Macintosh IIx • Macintosh IIcx • Macintosh IIsi • Macintosh IIfx • Macintosh IIfx • Macintosh IIfx
