DISCUSSION

The Apple Hard Disk 80SC provides disk storage for Macintosh, Apple IIe, and Apple IIGS computers. It allows you to access data up to six times faster than 3.5-inch floppy-disk drives. SCSI expansion lets you connect as many as three additional SCSI devices to an Apple IIe or Apple IIGS or as many as six to a Macintosh.
