On Macintosh systems with third-party internal SCSI hard drive, does the drive need to provide termination power, or does the Macintosh supply this power?
DISCUSSION
The Macintosh Plus, Macintosh Portable, and Macintosh PowerBooks do not provide SCSI termination power. All other Macintosh computers provide internal termination power with the exception of the Macintosh 630 family as they utilize an IDE style hard drive.
