| Paper |
| Apple recommends using coated paper with the Apple Color Printer for optimum printing quality, though the printer will accept plain copier paper. Plain paper is satisfactory for printing text, but the ink tends to bleed noticeably when printing graphics. |
| Apple does market coated paper for the Apple Color Printer, although you can use any coated paper which is labeled "for use with plain paper ink-jet printers." |
| Transparency Film |
| Use only transparency film that is recommended "for plain paper ink-jet printers." If normal transparency film is used, the ink will not dry on the plastic. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc. |
