

Font Substitution: Print Driver Substitutes 4 Fonts (7/93)

TOPIC -----

Only four specific fonts get substituted when Font Substitution is turned on. The substitutions are as follows:

- New York changes to Times
- Geneva changes to Helvetica
- Monaco changes to Courier
- Seattle changes to a modified version of Helvetica

Is this a feature implemented by the LaserWriter driver?

DISCUSSION -----

This feature is implemented by the print driver, which performs the substitution when it senses that one of the four bitmap fonts are being used. Thus, while the print driver is converting the QuickDraw commands to PostScript and Font Substitution is checked, the driver generates the PostScript commands to use a Type 1 font instead of generating the PostScript for a bitmap.
