

TrueType: TrueType Already Installed Error (7/94)

TOPIC
When my computer starts up, it gives me an error that says, "TrueType is alreadinstalled skipping Installation". What causes this error?
DISCUSSION
There are two occasions when this error message appears during the startup process:
1) If you are using System 7.x and install the TrueType init in your System Folder or Extensions Folder.
 System 7.x already has TrueType built into the operating system, so the TrueType Init is not required. Removing the TrueType Init from your System or Extensions folder corrects the problem.
2) If you are using System 6.0.7 or 6.0.8 and get the error message at startup, then you have two copies of the TrueType Init installed.
 Removing the additional TrueType Init from the System folder, corrects the problem. Remove the oldest version of the TrueType Init if they are different versions.
