What cables does the ImageWriter LQ use to connect to all Apple computers?

DISCUSSION -----

The ImageWriter LQ connects to Apple computers with the following cables:

Note that the cables are listed with their Finished Goods part number followed by their Apple Service part number, where available, in parentheses.

M0196 (590-0551)	Macintosh 512 and 512K (Macintosh 128K is not compatible with the ImageWriter LQ printer driver)
M0197 (590-0552) or M2068 - LocalTalk connector	All other Macintosh computers, PowerBook MiniDock, PowerBook Duo Dock, and Apple IIGS
A9C0314 (590-0556) (w/Super Serial Card jumper set to Terminal) or A2C0312 (590-0555) (w/Super Serial Card jumper set to Modem)	Apple II, Apple II Plus, and Apple IIe
A2C4313 (590-0554)	Apple IIc
M0197 (590-0552)	Apple IIc Plus
