LaserWriter: Two-Side Printing Not Recommended

TOPIC -----

Is it safe to print on both sides of the page when using an Apple LaserWriter?

DISCUSSION -----

It is NOT recommended that you print on both sides of the paper with the LaserWriter.

The reason for this is that when the paper passes through the printer twice you are heating the toner again, making it brittle. This toner can then break off, getting onto the rollers and then possibly being transferred to the next piece of paper through the printer.

It would be probably be better to use a copy machine for that.
