LaserWriter IINT Manual Feed: Why Paper-Out Light Stays Lit

TOPIC -----

When I print from the manual-feed tray on my LaserWriter IINT, the paper-out status light stays lit. I can still print from the tray without any problem, but the only way I can clear the status light is to open and shut the printer cover.

DISCUSSION -----

There is a bug in the LaserWriter IINT ROM that causes this. If you have a piece of paper in the manual-feed tray when you issue a manual-feed print job, the status light stays on after the print cycle. The workaround is to send the manual-feed print job, then wait until the status light is blinking before you insert the piece of paper.

There is no other workaround for this problem, and none is planned because it is a cosmetic problem and does not affect the actual operation of the printer.
