| I upgraded my LaserWriter IINT to a LaserWriter IIg. The IIg will not print any apostrophes or tildes. I can replace the printer's logic board with a IINT and it will print the tilde and apostrophe. |
| DISCUSSION |
| Try removing New Century Schoolbook font and rebooting. The New Century Schoolbook font that ships with the IIf/IIg is damaged. This font will cause the tilde and apostrophe to fail to print. |
| Reinstall the font from the Font Pack diskettes rather than from the LaserWriter Pro or LaserWriter IIf disks. |
