## LaserWriter Pro 630: Printing Times New Roman Font (6/94)

TOPIC
I am having trouble printing files with Times New Roman II fonts in them. This occurs from several different Macintosh computers printing to a LaserWriter Pro 630. A PostScript error occurs when printing this font and the printer drops off the network 3 out of 4 times. Is there a compatibility problem with this font and printer?
DISCUSSION
From the details you provide we cannot be sure you have encountered this incompatibility, we have previously received reports of a problem printing documents containing the Times New Roman font on a LaserWriter Pro 630 when using the LaserWriter 7.2 driver. This problem is resolved by using either the LaserWriter 7.1.2 or LaserWriter 8.1.1 drivers; therefore, we recommend you use either of these drivers, but preferably LaserWriter 8.1.1 since it is a PostScript Level 2 driver and provides greater use of the LaserWriter Pro 630's features, such as paper trays.
If you continue to have problems when using LaserWriter 8.1.1, please:
<ol> <li>Throw away the LaserWriter 8 prefs file in the Preferences folder inside the System Folder.</li> <li>Reboot your Macintosh with Extensions OFF.</li> <li>Select the LaserWriter 8.1.1 driver then try printing.</li> </ol>
If the problems persist after following these steps, then:
<ol> <li>Perform a clean install of system software 7.1</li> <li>Install the LaserWriter 8.1.1 driver using its installer.</li> <li>Install the Times New Roman font.</li> </ol>
