I've got a LaserWriter Pro 810 and some UNIX workstations without floppy drives. My understanding is the LaserWriter Pro 810 UNIX disk is in UNIX or tar format, and is unreadable from a DOS or Macintosh computer.
Is there an ftp site where the LaserWriter Pro 810 UNIX software can be found?
DISCUSSION
You are correct, the LaserWriter Pro 810 Utility for UNIX workstations was distributed in UNIX tar format on a floppy disk, which cannot be read from a DOS or Macintosh computer.
We have generated a compressed tar format file of the LaserWriter Pro 810 Utility for a generic UNIX workstation. It can be found at:
